Abstracts

Make sure that the abstract is no longer than 300 words. Please use the following abstract format:

Title – Informative and attractive title containing the main message of your research.

Authors – List of all authors and their affiliations and contact details. Please indicate, who is the corresponding author.

Background and aim – Present your research motivation and research aim.

Methods / Methodology – Present briefly the used research methods/approach to answer the aim.

Results – Present your main research findings.

Originality (if applicable) – Indicate the novelty of your research in science.

Practical or social implications – Identify the (potential) implications for practice.

Keywords – 4-7 key concepts or words.

Type of paper – Please indicate if your paper is a research paper, technical paper, viewpoint paper or an educational paper.

TYPES OF PAPERS

Research paper – Focuses on scientific advancement of the field. Includes strong theoretical foundation.

Technical paper – Focuses on process and results of the research. Often referred as applied research and produced by/for an organisation.

Viewpoint paper – Focuses on key challenges, issues, and developments in FM. May provide authors' viewpoint backed with references.

Educational paper – Focuses on the principles and practices in FM education. Encourages novel approaches to teaching and learning.
